DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located on the east side of San Mar Road, south of Mt. Lena and southeast of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on level high ground and faces east. It is a one and a half story, two bay stone building sheathed with rough cast or stucco with a frame leanto addition attached to its end wall.

Windows have narrow frames and appear to be replacements of the originals. They hold two over two pane sashes. The openings in the front elevation are placed rather closely together near the center of the wall. The door is located in the southernmost bay. It has no transom and is of lower height than the window beside it. A hipped roof porch extends across the front elevation.

Corrugated sheet metal covers the roof which extends beyond the end walls. A moderately large brick chimney is located inside the south end wall.


