DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead is located on the north side of Benevola Church Road east of Benevola, north of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. The buildings are situated on the north side of the road and face south.

The house is a two story, three bay wooden building possibly of log construction and covered with composition siding over weatherboards. Extending perpendicular to the main section is a two story, three bay ell also covered with composition siding.

Windows have early 20th century architraves with flat top pieces. Two over two pane sashes are present, flanked with pairs of shutters with movable louvers.

The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. A one story porch covered with wysteria extends across the front elevation. A two story porch is included under the main roof span of the ell.

The roof is covered with slates and extends beyond the end walls. Brick chimneys with corbels are located inside the west and north gables. A modern brick flue is attached to the exterior of the east end wall.

A large frame bank barn and related outbuildings are located behind the house.

The structures are in fair to good condition.


