DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This log house is located on the west side of Mt. Lena Road just south of Black Rock Road and faces east. It is a one and a half story structure with a one story German sided extension to the rear. Resting on low fieldstone foundations, the logs are exposed at all elevations of the front section and are joined at the corners with the typical inverted V notch. Chinking and daubing remains in good condition in the south and east elevations.

Windows have narrow frames and most are trimmed with plain late 19th century style architraves with pointed top pieces. A four panel door with a plain transom is located in the center bay of the front elevation.

Small brick chimneys are located inside the end walls. An exterior stone and brick chimney is located against the extension. Corrugated sheet metal finishes the roof.


