DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This complex is located on the south side of Ridenour Road, north of I-70 and southeast of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland.

Present is a two story three bay shingle sided house with a two story, four bay ell extension and a one and a half story, three bay stone house. The sided house may be of log construction. Its exterior appearance reflects early 20th century construction with elements such as single pane sash windows, flat topped architraves and porches supported by rock faced concrete block pillars. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation and includes a single pane transom above the door. Entrances and a porch are also located on the south side of the ell.

The second dwelling is a 19th century building of roughly coursed fieldstone with a modern bow window installed in its front elevation.


