The house is a two story, seven bay brick structure with a four bay recessed double porch along part of the front elevation. Common bond brick work is used at all elevations.

A frame bank barn and various agricultural outbuildings are located nearby.








E) KEEDYSVILLE 16 MI | 40' | 271 | ZITLSTOWN 15 MI | FREDERICK 14 MI
