This farm is located on the north side of Monroe Road, north of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland.

The house is a two story, six bay brick structure with a three bay recessed double porch included under the main roof span. A date stone in the end wall is inscribed with the year 1851.

Windows have narrow frames with wide wooden lintels.

Ruins of a stone end barn which shows evidence of having been enlarged stand nearby.




