DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This stone house is located on the corner of Eakle's Mill Road and Marble Quarry Road southeast of Keedysville in Washington County, Maryland.

Facing west, the house is a two story, three bay stone structure with a one story, two bay stone wing extending to the rear. Interrupting the roof line at the front elevation is a gothic wall dormer or cross gable with a pointed window and gingerbread trim.

The entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation.

According to the owner, the house is dated 1829.


