DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmhouse is constructed of brick in common bond and painted red. It is a two story, five bay structure with the two easternmost bays of the front or south elevation recessed beneath a double porch included under the main roof span. Windows have six over six pane double hung sashes. According to an occupant of the house, it was built about 1854. Located near the house is a brick smoke house with a hipped roof and a frame bank barn.
