DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story four bay brick house would appear to date from the late 19th century. It is an L-shaped house constructed in common bond at all elevations. Windows have segmentally arched tops with two over two pane sashes. An elaborate Victorian porch with heavy turnings shelters the two front doors centered in the wall. Other structures include a frame bank barn and a frame outbuilding with an exterior stone chimney.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This farmhouse shows characteristics of late 19th century construction in Washington County. The farm is located near Smoketown, the site of a hospital used after the Civil War Battle of Antietam. According to an Antietam Battlefield historical marker, this was George Line's house in which General Mansfield died. From the exterior, however, the house does not appear old enough to have been standing at the time of the Battle in 1862.






