STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The ruins of the stone building displays typical stone construction techniques of Washington County from the second quarter of the 19th century. The stone culvert of chiseled blocks with a prominent keystone at the top of the arch is typical of canal stone masonry which differs from vernacular stone construction in the County.




