DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead consists of a group of stone and log buildings which appear to date from the first quarter of the 19th century. The house is a two story, five bay structure of coursed local limestone with flat arches of finely dressed stone above the ground and main story windows. Sashes appear to have been replaced and Victorian brackets were added at the eaves. A recessed double porch extends along part of the rear or north wall of the house. In front of the house is an elaborate iron fence. Behind the house is a log outbuilding with board and batten siding. Also present is a stone root cellar or ice house with an arched entrance diagonally slanted down from the ground level. Part of the roof framing for the stone outbuilding appears to have been an old rafter plate from another structure. Also present is a large stone end barn.




