STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is an example of construction utilizing the native limestone. Many houses built of stone exist in Washington County, most dating from the late 18th through the first half of the 19th centuries. This house would appear to date from the mid 19th century. An occupant said that according to local tradition, it was built by Sam Bland, a black man. If this is true, it should be noted for its contribution to local black history.
