DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This complex consists of an early 19th century stone house and barn with related domestic and agricultural outbuildings. The house is a two part stone structure, its main section being a two story five bay building with a central entrance. The walls are constructed of coursed native limestone and most windows are topped with flat arches of more finely dressed stone. To the east gable end of this structure is a two story two bay section with a recessed double porch. This part of the house displays a later type of masonry than that associated with the main section. According to an occupant, however, the basement of the apparently newer section has a puncheon, beam and mortar insulation system associated with 18th century construction in Washington County. The gable roofed front porch at the main entrance is of a type which could date from the early 19th century.
