DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is built of rock faced concrete block. It is a two story, five bay structure with a hipped roof punctuated by cross gables centered on the front and side walls. All windows have segmentally arched tops accented with a lighter colored block. Similar blocks are used for decorative quions at the corners. Centered in the front elevation at the second story level is a palladian window. Extending around most of the house is a one story porch with a central pedimented pavilion at the main entrance. This house is very similar to another structure built by the same family and located at Sharpsburg. See WA-II-385.


