DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm house is a two story, seven bay brick building with common bonding at all elevations. The four northernmost bays of the front or east elevation are recessed beneath a double porch. Windows have six over six pane sashes below wide wooden lintels. A series of large dentils extends across the front wall under the eaves. The interior of the house features grained woodwork, five panel doors and mantelpieces following Greek Revival motifs. Behind the house is a stone outkitchen. A modern barn is present.




