Description

This house is a two story, three bay L-shaped frame structure sheathed with German siding. It has a central cross gable. Exterior trims and finishes, including molded flat top architraves with cut work trim are typical of ca. 1900. Windows have two over two pane sash. The high front porch is supported by turned posts with brackets. The railing has turned balusters as well. The roofing material is standing seam sheet metal. A one story wash house is attached at the rear.

According to the local historians, this house was built by Christian Keedy in 1870. It replaced an older log house that has been the home of Margaret Kitzmiller who took care of Oliver Wendell Holmes, Jr. when he was injured in the Battle of Antietam.


