Description

This brick house is 1½ stories high with a raised basement. Built into a bank or steep slope, it is four bays wide with its main entrance in the north end bay of the front. The foundation is stone and includes the raised basement which has two full six over six windows and a door with transom in the east or front. Other windows are six over six except for the upper half story which has eight-light windows. A high porch, reached by stairs at the north end shelters the main story front and the basement. Roofing material is standing seam sheet metal.

This house is said to have been lived in by a member of the Keedy family. The 1877 Atlas shows it as owned by C. Nichodemus. In the 20th century it housed Lynch's Barber Shop in the basement.




