Description

This building is a two and a half story frame structure with a raised basement, part of the limestone foundation. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. Windows have two over two pane sash. The exposed basement wall is smooth stuccoed. A semi-hexagonal projecting bay is supported by large brackets.

According to local historians, the basement was used as a school.


