**Description**


Probably dating from the 1830s or '40s is this two story, three bay log house sheathed with German siding. It has single pane sash windows and a central entrance. An exterior brick chimney is located at the north gable end. An early 20th century porch supported by round doric columns extends across the front and south elevations. North of the house is a small gable fronted frame garage.

This house dates from after the completion of the Sharpsburg-Boonsboro Turnpike in the 1830s, as shown by its orientation to the street. The property was owned by S. Lantz in the 1870s.




