This farmhouse is a two story, five bay brick structure with a two story, two bay frame extension. The brick section is constructed in common bond at all elevations and has wide wooden lintels above six over six windows. The main entrance is in the central bay of the front elevation of the brick section. Below the main dwelling is a stone spring house.




