The stone house is a two-story stone structure constructed in a rectangular plan. It is three-bays by one-bay and has a frame addition on the rear. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with a central entrance and six-over-one windows in the outer bays of the first story and the three bays of the second story. There is a full-length one-story front porch supported by columns with a spindle railing. The structure has a boxed cornice and a gable roof. The structure appears to date from the mid-19th century.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook Road, approximately .08 mile east of Clark Road, in Sandy Hook. The house is located close to the road on a gently sloping site. There is a picket fence surrounding the property. The main facade faces south.

The two-story structure is constructed of stone in a rough-laid bond with large stone quoins. The main visual effect of the structure comes from the painted joints of the stone work. There is a central entrance with a small transom. Six-over-one windows are in the outer bays of the first story and single bays of each gable end. Slightly shorter six-over-one windows are located on the second story in the three bays of the main facade and the single bays on the gable end. The porch is slightly elevated on brick plinths with lattice-work between the plinths. The porch has a hipped roof covered in sheet metal supported by round columns and spindle railings. The structure has a boxed cornice. The roof is covered in sheet metal. There is a interior-end brick chimney on the east gable end.
