The frame house is a two-story frame structure constructed in a rectangular plan. The main section is six-bays by two-bays with a full-length, one-story porch. The exterior has a vertical board siding. The structure has a gable roof covered in sheet metal. The structure appears to date from the late 19th century.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook Road, approximately .035 mile east of Clark Road, in Sandy Hook. The structure sets right up on the road. The main facade faces south.

The two-story structure is constructed of frame covered in a vertical board siding. The structure is on a fieldstone foundation with a full-length, one-story front porch on a concrete block foundation. The front porch has a hipped roof covered in sheet metal and is supported on chamfered posts. The first story of the main section has six bays with entrances in the second and fifth bays. One-over-one sash windows are in the other bays of the first story. On the second story, windows are in the bays above the windows of the first story (with the bays above the doors being unfenestrated). The gable ends have windows on the first and second story and small windows in each gable. Some of the sash on the gable ends have six-over-six pane which is probably what was originally on the structure. The house has a gable roof covered in sheet metal. Interior-end brick chimneys rise from each gable end.
