The frame house is a two-story frame structure covered in German siding. It has a five-bay by one-bay main section with a one-story, two-bay rear addition. The main facade is asymmetrical with a gable over the westernmost two bays. There is a full-length, one-story front porch. Window and door trim include pointed-arch cornices. The structure has a fieldstone foundation.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook Road, approximately .025 mile east of Clark Road, in Sandy Hook. The house sits fairly close to the road. The main facade faces south.

The two and one-half story structure is constructed of frame covered in German siding on a fieldstone foundation. The main facade is asymmetrically arranged with a gable over the two westernmost bays. The gable has a boxed cornice that returns at the ends and a pointed-arch window. The structure has a central entrance with two-over-two sash windows in the other bays on the first story and the five-bays on the second story. There is a full-length, one-story front porch with a shed roof on square posts with bracket ornamentation. The corners of the structure have corner boards. The one-story, rear addition has a shed roof and two-over-two sash windows. The house has a boxed cornice that returns at the ends. The roof is covered in asphalt shingles. There is an interior-end brick chimney at the east gable end.
