The frame house is a two-story frame structure constructed in a L-shape plan. It has a three-bay by two-bay main section with a one-story rear addition. It **is** constructed in a slight slope with a high fieldstone foundation on the front. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with a central entrance and a one-story, full-length porch. Early features of the house include its six-over-six sash and its central location for an interior chimney stack. This structure appears to date from the mid-19th century.

The property is located on the northwest corner of the intersection of Sandy Hook and Clark Roads. The structure sits up on the road with a stone retaining wall at road level. The main facade faces south.

The two-story structure is constructed of frame covered in asphalt shingles. A fieldstone foundation runs the full-length of the house and supports the front porch. The main facade has a central entrance. Six-over-six sash windows are located in the outer bays of the first story and outer bays of the second story. The center bay of the second story is unfenestrated. Six-over-six windows are also in the two bays of **both** stories on the gable ends. A single window in each gable. The full-length, one-story porch has a hipped roof on square posts with a paneled railing. The structure has a gable roof. An interior brick chimney rises from the center of the house at the peak of the roof. The one-story rear addition is one-bay wide and has a series of windows along it.

There are no significant outbuildings on the property.
