The stone house is a two-story stone structure in a rectangular plan. It is four-bays by one-bay and has a gable roof. The stone work is covered in a stucco and painted white. The structure has entrances in the two central bays and six-over-six windows in the outer bays of the first story. There is a full-length, one-story porch. The second story has six-over-three sash windows. This is one of the few stone houses in Sandy Hook that remains in a fairly original state. The structure appears to date from the mid-19th century.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook Road, approximately .22 mile west of Clark Road, in Sandy Hook. The house sits back slightly from the road and the main story is slightly below current ground level. The main facade faces south.

The two-story structure is constructed of stone covered in stucco and painted white. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with entrances in the two central bays, six-over-six windows in the outer bays of the first story, six-over-three windows in the four bays of the second story, and a full-length, one-story porch. The porch has chamfered posts and a shed roof. The porch and the structure are slightly below ground level. The gable ends are unfenestrated. The structure has a boxed cornice. The gable roof is covered in sheet metal. Interior-end brick chimneys rise from each gable end of the roof.

There are no significant outbuildings on the property.
