The frame bungalow is a one-story structure on a **high** concrete block foundation. The foundation forms a full-story and contains a automobile garage on its west side. The main facade of the structure is the gable front with a full-length, one-story porch. The structure is three-bays by three-bays. The date of construction is early 20th century.

The property is located on the east side of Clark Road, approximately .1 mile north of Sandy Hook Road, in Sandy Hook. The structure is **built in** a slight slope in the ground. The main facade faces south.

The one-story structure is constructed of frame covered in asphalt shingles. The foundation level is a full-story on the front of the house with large wood **doors for a** automobile garage on the west facade. The main facade is asymmetrical with a slightly off-center door and one-over-one sash windows in the outer bays. There is a full-length, one-story front porch with a shed roof supported on square posts with stick **railing**. In the gable is a one-pane square window. The sides have three one-over-one sash windows. The roof **has** a boxed cornice and is covered in sheet metal.

There are no significant outbuildings on the property.
