The frame house is a two-story frame structure constructed in a L-shape plan. It has a three-bay by ~~one~~-bay main section and a two-bay ell. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with a central entrance and a full-length, one-story porch. The frame structure is covered in a modern aluminum siding. It has a gable roof covered in sheet metal. The key ornamental components of the house are the late Victorian-style decoration on the full-length porch including a cut-out railing and semi-circle brackets, quarter round brackets, and pendants. The structure appears to date from the late 19th century.

The property is located on the north side of Sandy Hook, approximately .22 mile east of Clark Road. The house sits on a sharp bluff above the road.

The two story structure is constructed of frame covered in modern aluminum siding on a fieldstone foundation. The structure is built into a slope in the ground and the main facade is at ground level with the full story foundation. The foundation level is enclosed in lattice-work under the porch. The main facade is symmetrically arranged with a central entrance and two-over-two sash windows on the outer bays of the first story and the three bays of the second story. The full-length, one-story porch is supported by square posts with bracket ornamentation and pendants. The cut-out railing has a spindle design. The gable ends have a single two-over-two window on each story. The ell wing has an one story porch on the east facade. The roof has a boxed cornice and is covered in sheet metal. Interior-end brick chimney stacks rise from each gable end.

There are no significant outbuildings on the property.
