DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This stone farmhouse is a two story, five bay structure, The two eastern bays of its front or south elevation are recessed to form a double porch which has since been enclosed with wooden siding. Relatively large stones are used in the walls arranged in rough courses. Wedge shaped keystones are present above the windows and doors. The back of one mantelpiece is dated 1825. In front of the house is a large spring fed pond with a two story stone springhouse and a secondary dwelling. Its masonry consists of uniform narrow courses of a type associated with 18th century stone construction. In the springhouse was a cast iron stove with the inscription D & S Hughes and the motto "Don't Give Up the Ship." A cast relief of a tall ship with swags along the bottom of the side plates decorated the stove.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This stone house, dated 1825 shows construction characteristics of the 1820's period, particularly in the type of masonry and the window treatment. The house may be predated by the stone springhouse. Another significant feature of the property is the 19th century Hughes Brothers Stove. Daniel and Samuel Hughes who operated the Mt. Aetna iron furnace in Washington County were major iron producers for Maryland and areas of Pennsylvania and Virginia.


