DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This stone farmhouse is a two story, six bay structure with a two bay recessed double porch at one end of the front elevation. The walls are made of rough courses of brownish stone. Wide wooden lintels are present above the windows. All windows have six over six pane sashes some of which may be replacements. The main door has six low relief panels and is hung beneath a four light transom. Interior woodwork includes door architraves with decorated corner blocks in the front rooms and fireplace mantels with colonnettes. The back and sides of the house are sheathed with stucco. The front elevation was probably stuccoed also at one time. Also on the property is a frame bank barn.
