This stone and frame building would appear to have been a stable or carriage house. It is now part of the Smithsburg Reservoir property. The building is a two story structure with a stone base with frame gables with applied decorative shingle sheathing. A square tower with a hipped roof is attached to the front of the structure. Openings in the stone section of the building have segmentally arched tops. Beside this building is a small stone springhouse with a hipped roof.


