This complex includes a two and a half story stone house with a double porch along its front elevation. It is built of the brownish granular stone found along South Mountain. Near the house is a series of outbuildings, a frame bank barn and a complex of packing houses. The house would appear to date from the first half of the 19th century. The property is part of a large orchard.


