DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmhouse is a two story, six bay brick structure with a recessed double porch along the three southern bays of the front or west elevation. Common bond brick work was used for the side and rear walls and the recessed part of the front elevation while the main section of the front wall displays Flemish bonding. Nine over six windows are used at the first story level while six over six sashes are present above the doors. Behind the house is a brick smoke house, a log outbuilding, and sided out kitchen. A large frame bank barn is also part of the complex.


