DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Winders Farm is improved with a two story, two part sided log and brick house, a stuccoed stone smoke house, a German sided outkitchen and other outbuildings. The main part of the house is a two story, three bay gable front log structure sheathed with random width weatherboarding. Attached at right angles to it is a one story, two bay German sided wing. Added to the gable end of the main log section is a one bay brick extension, painted white. Some windows retain early wide frames while others have had late 19th century style pointed architraves applied.


