DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick farmhouse would appear to date from the second quarter of the 19th century. It is a two story, three bay structure with a one story, two bay stuccoed stone extension attached to the rear elevation. The front of the brick section has Flemish bonding with high flat arches of angle formed bricks above the first story openings. The eaves are finished with courses of decorative brick corbeling. At the front entrance is an eight panel door. Near the house is a frame bank barn.


