DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Mt. Zion Methodist Church is a one story two bay structure with a three bay gable front. It would appear to be of logs or timber framed and is sheathed with imitation brick composition siding. Windows have six over six pane sashes and early 20th century style architraves. A modern entrance bay has been added. A small hip roofed belfry is present at the front of the building.


