STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This farmstead was not observed closely enough to allow for an estimate of its age. The house may be of log construction beneath the weatherboarding. The springhouse appears to have been a general service building. Most probably, the structure dates from the pre-1850 period. They are a typical 19th century rural group.


