This house is a secondary dwelling on a large farm. It is a two story, four bay structure which would appear to be built of logs. A one and a half story wing is attached. The entire building is sheathed with composition siding. The two center bays are identical front doors. There are no windows above them at the second story level. The exterior surfaces of this house are of a type associated with the early 20th century. The actual structure may, however, be older.


