DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two and one half story, three bay German sided log building with an exterior brick chimney which appears to be modern. A two bay ell extension is attached to the rear of the building. Two gable roofed dormers each with a six over six sash protrude from the south or front slope of the roof. A four light transom is present over the central front entrance. Agricultural buildings are also a part of the complex.


