This log house is a two story, two bay structure covered with board and batten siding. The interior surface of the logs is whitewashed. All interior and exterior woodwork, construction elements and trim that were observed date from the turn of the century period. Doors and windows are placed at random in the walls.

A frame bank barn is located south of the house.


