DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house on this farm is a two part T-shaped structure with each section having an exterior stone chimney. The main and probably elder part of the house is a one and a half story structure sheathed with composition siding, possibly over log construction. Exposed windows at the back of the house have six over six pane sashes. A two bay, extension, presumably an addition forms the stem of the T, extending from the south or front elevation of the main section. It may be of log or frame construction. Its exterior chimney does not appear to be as old as that on the other part of the house. It narrows to a small brick flue above the fire box.

Behind the house are a frame barn and outbuildings.


