DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This building is a two part log house sheathed with board and batten siding. The three northern bays are a full two stories in height with six over six windows. Attached to it at the south is a one and a half story, three bay section with an exterior stone chimney topped with brick. At the north end of the house is an inside end brick flue. The exterior and interior finishes that were observed could not be dated before the mid 19th century.
