This stone farmhouse is a two story, five bay structure built of native redish brown grandular stone. The masonry consists of roughly coursed large blocks. Smaller bricks are centered above the windows suggesting keystones. All windows and doors have been replaced and are modern. The entrance does however, include a transom and sidelights. A two story, two bay frame ell has been added to the rear of the house.

Also on the property is a frame bank barn with outbuildings.

This stone farmhouse probably dates from the mid 19th century. It follows a typical regional form but is constructed of a different type of stone from the grey limestone rock utilized east of Clear Spring.


