DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

7 This house is located on the west side of Shanktown Road at the eastern edge of Fort Frederick State Park in Washington County. It appears to date from the early 20th century. The house is a two story, three bay balloon frame structure resting on concrete sheathed foundations. Its walls are covered with asbestos shingles. Windows have two over two pane sashes with flat topped architraves having simple moldings.

The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. Above the door is a narrow transom. The door architrave has fluted trim resembling pilasters supporting a shelf-like projection at the top.

The roof is of corrugated sheet metal and extends beyond the end walls of the house. Brick chimneys are located inside the end walls.

A small hipped roof porch gives access to a side entrance.

The house, although vacant, appears to be in fair to good condition.
