This stuccoed farmhouse would appear to date from the last quarter of the 19th century. It is a two story, five bay structure L-shaped with a two story, three bay wing extending to the rear. The building may be of brick construction. Windows have two over two pane sashes with arched tops. The main entrance has an arched topped transom and sidelights around the door.

Behind the house is a brick outkitchen.
