Description

Three bay, one story log structure covered with German siding at the front elevation. It probably dates from the early 19th century. It has an inside end chimney and windows with two over two pane sashes. It reflects the earlier (18th and early 19th century) housing yet remaining in Williamsport.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This three bay, one story log structure is sheathed with German siding at the front or east elevation and vertical siding at the end wall. Windows have two over two pane double hung sashes and are rather large relative to wall area. The main entrance is located at the north bay and consists of a four panel door hung beneath a transom which has been covered over. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal. The chimney is located inside the south end wall. This small house may date from the early 19th century.
