DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Williamsport City Hall is located on the northwest corner of West Salisbury and North Conococheague Streets, facing east. It is a two story, five bay, stone Georgian Revival Style structure dating from the early 20th century. First story windows are arched with eight over eight pane sashes. Second story windows have similar sashes without the arched tops. The main entrance is in the center bay of the front elevation and is adorned with a one story curved porch. The building has a hipped roof with a wooden balustrade near its top. Centrally placed at the peak of the roof is a polyagonal cupola.


