DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story, four bay frame double house stands on the west side of North Conococheague Street, facing east. It is built into a slope so that the stone foundations expose a full story at the front elevation. A shed roof front porch has a set of steps at either end, one for each side of the house. It has a standing seam tin roof, asbestos siding and two over two double hung sash. The woodwork on the porch and window architraves suggest a late 19th century construction date.


