DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Situated on the north side of East Potomac Street and facing south at the intersection with North Artizan Street, is this two story with finished third floor attic and a basement, brick house. It has a slate roof, cross shaped with four gables.

There are one over one sash, segmentally arched brick headers and a semi-hexagonal projecting bay on the west side, cross gable on the west side of the south front and a one story balustraded porch. Bricks are laid in all stretcher bond. It was built ca. 1900.
