Situated on the north side of West Salisbury Street facing south is this two story, four bay log residence. It has a standing seam tin roof, lap horizontal siding, six over six double hung sash on the second floor and one such sash on the first floor. There are two modified windows on the first floor with one over one light sash. There is a three bay, shallow hip roof front porch. This building was constructed in the 19th century.


