Situated on the north side of West Church Street facing south is a three story, mansard roof possibly log house and upper frame house. It has a slate roof, three dormers in the mansard roof, one over one double hung sash, a porch extending across the front all covered with asbestos siding. This is possibly a renovated 19th century log house. The work was done in the 1870's or 1880's.


